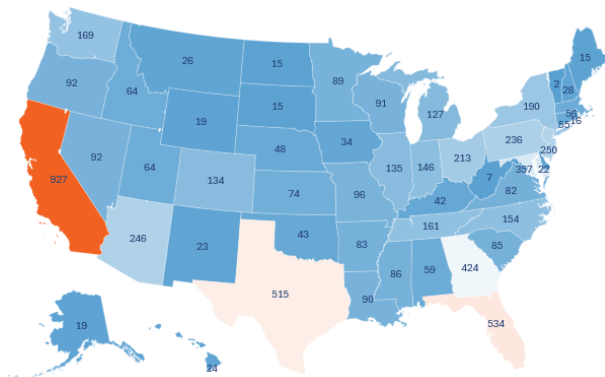

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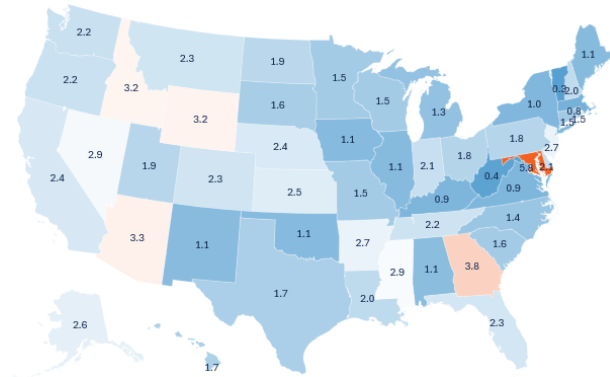
# Number of Medicare Certified ASCs

6,611 centers across 51 states and 3 US territories represent 2,113 cities. Figures 1 and 2 show the number of ASCs by state. The top 10 states with the most ASCs are listed in Table 1 and the top 10 cities are in Table 2. 91% of all ASCs have an urban (vs. rural) designation. Figure 3 displays the number of ASCs that were Medicare certified each year from 1980 to 2026.

**Figure 2. ASCs by State per 100,000 People**



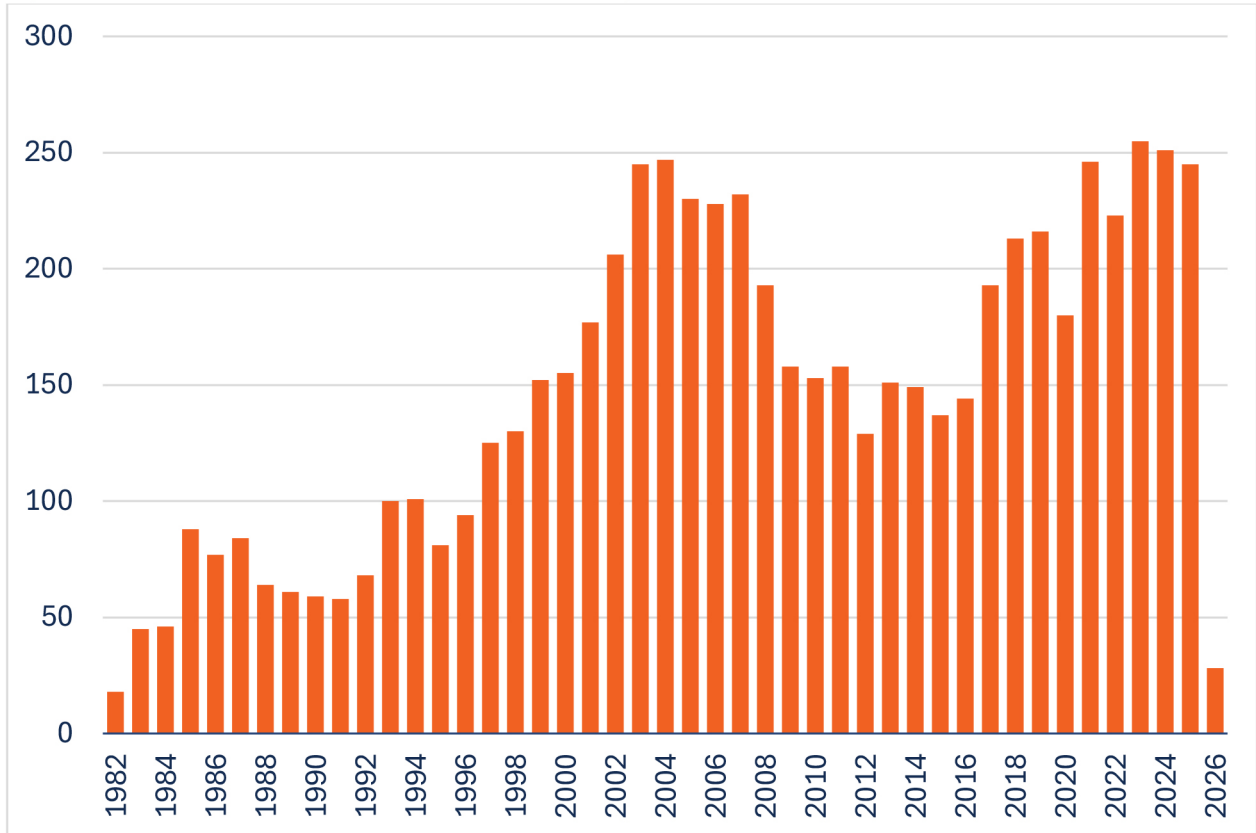

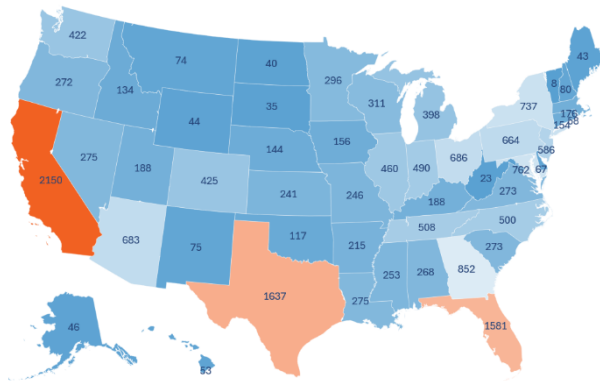


## Number of Operating Rooms (OR)

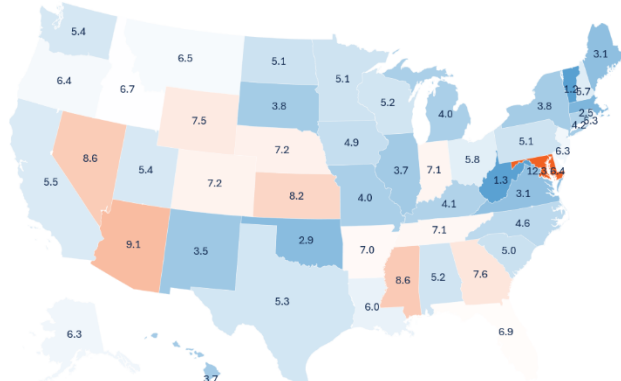

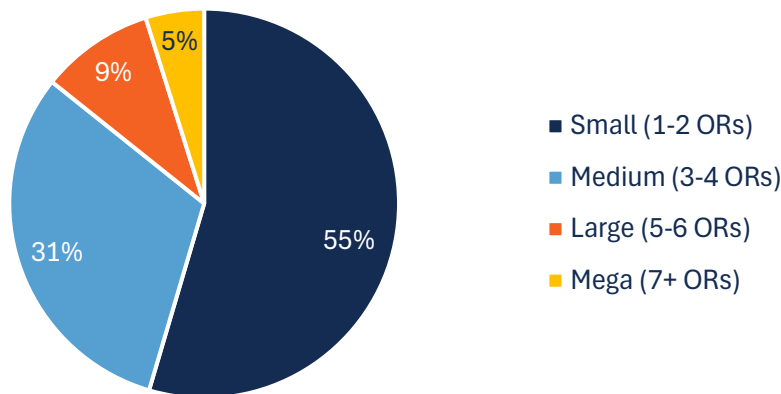
**Figure 4. Number of Operating Rooms per State**

Currently, there are 18,753 operating rooms across 6,611 Medicare certified ASCs. Consistent with state size and population, California, Florida, and Texas have the highest total number of ORs (California 2,150, Texas 1,637, Florida 1,581). Total number of ORs per state is represented in Figures 4 and 5. Figure 6 displays the distribution of ASCs by the size of the facility (determined by number of operating rooms). Table 5 lists the ASCs that had a change in the number of operating rooms from Q4 2025 to Q1 2026.

**Figure 6. Distribution of ASCs by Size of Facility (Number of Operating Rooms)**

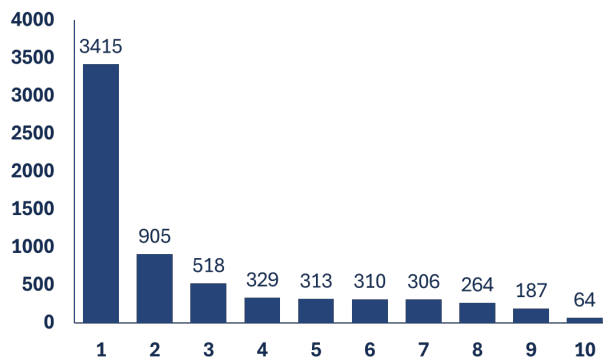




# Total Specialties

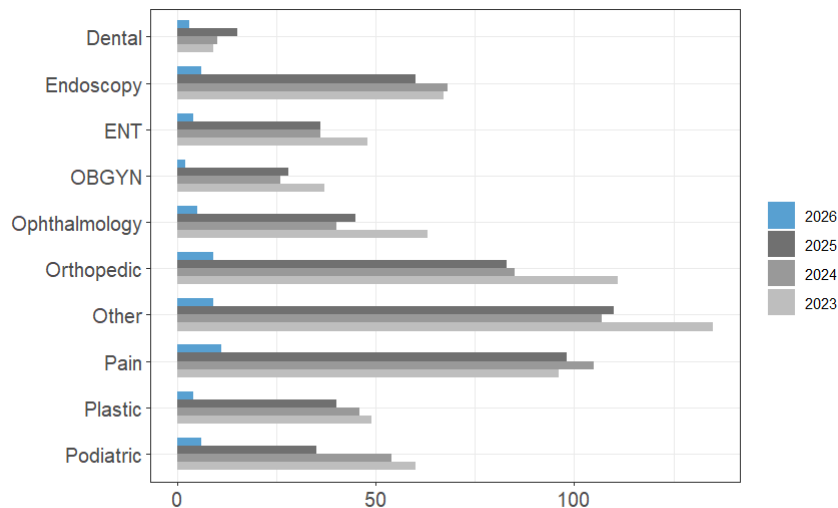
**Figure 7. Number of Medicare Certified ASCs by Total Specialties Offered**

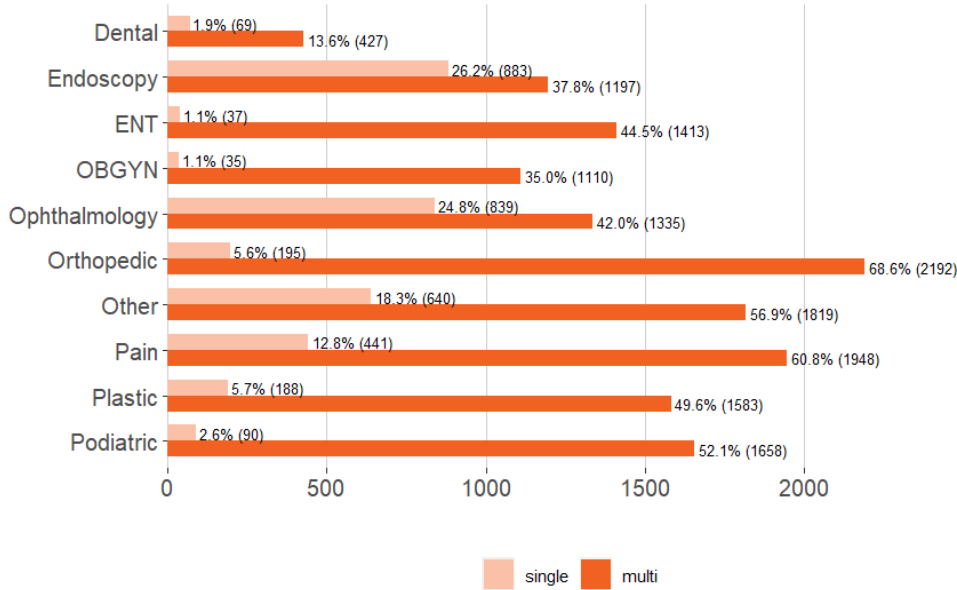
**Figure 10. Number of Medicare Certified ASCs by Specialty Type in 2026**

10 options for surgical specialties are reported for analysis. Most centers (3415, 51.7%) are a single specialty center followed by dual-specialty centers representing 13.7% (Figure 7, Table 6). Figure 8 shows how Medicare certification is tracking by specialty in 2026 compared to prior years. Figures 9 shows number of ASCs by specialty type from 2023 to 2026. Figure 10 shows number of ASCs by specialty type in 2026 and Figure 11 breaks this down by single- and multi-specialty centers.

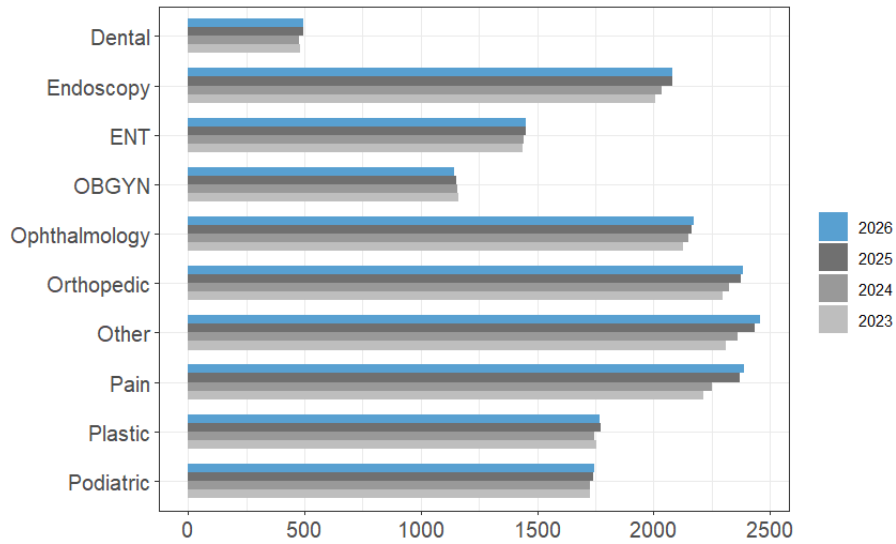

**Figure 8. Specialty Breakdown by Year of Original Medicare Participation**



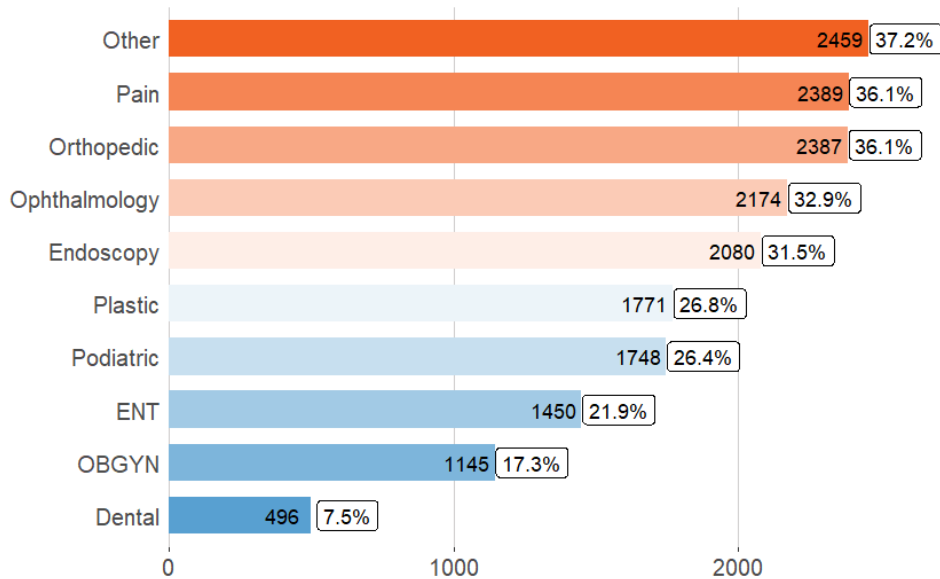

**Figure 9. Number of Medicare Certified ASCs by Specialty from 2023 to 2026**

The most common (26%) single specialty center specializes in endoscopy, followed closely by ophthalmology (25%). Table 10 characterizes the top 3 most common combinations of specialties for multi-specialty centers. Table 11 shows the percentage of Medicare certified ASCs that offer each specialty by total number of specialties offered. For example, 8% of dual specialty ASCs offer ENT surgery. Lastly, Table 12 shows the changes in specialties offered per ASC from Q4 2025 to Q1 2026.

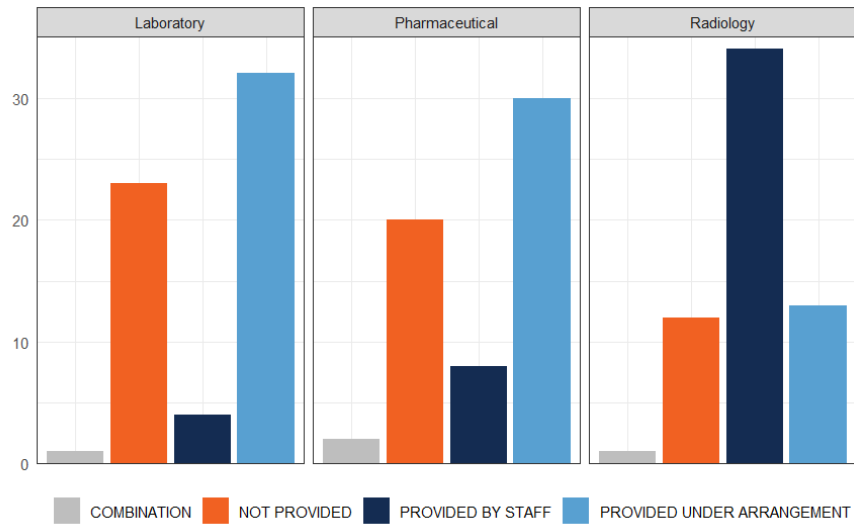

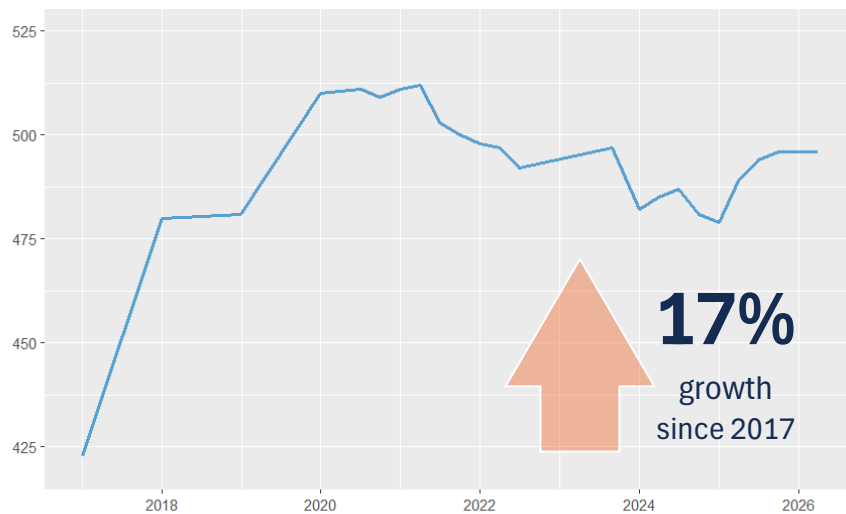

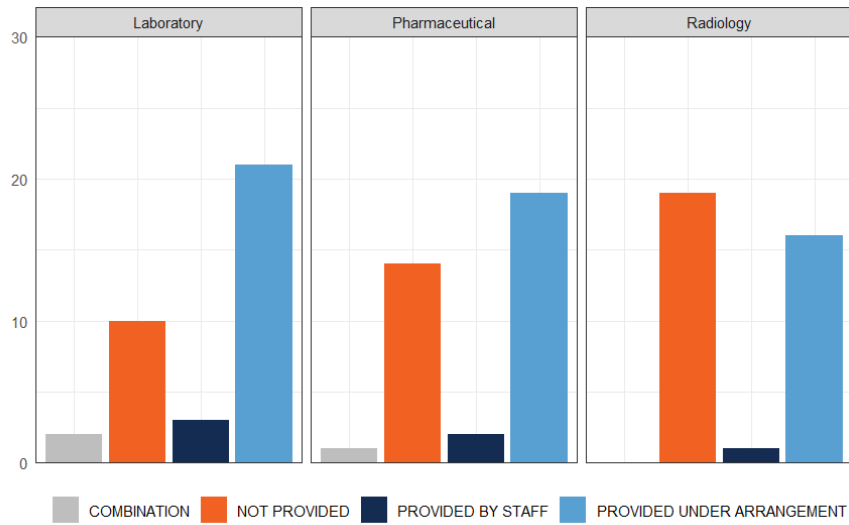

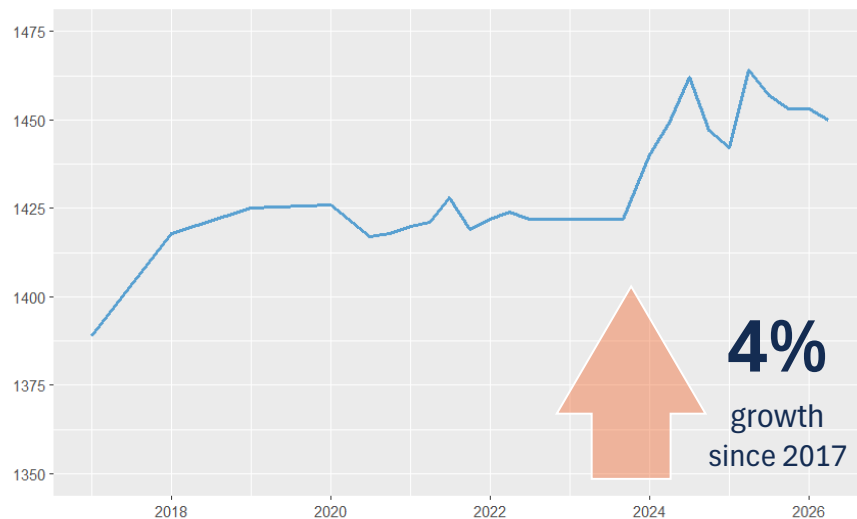

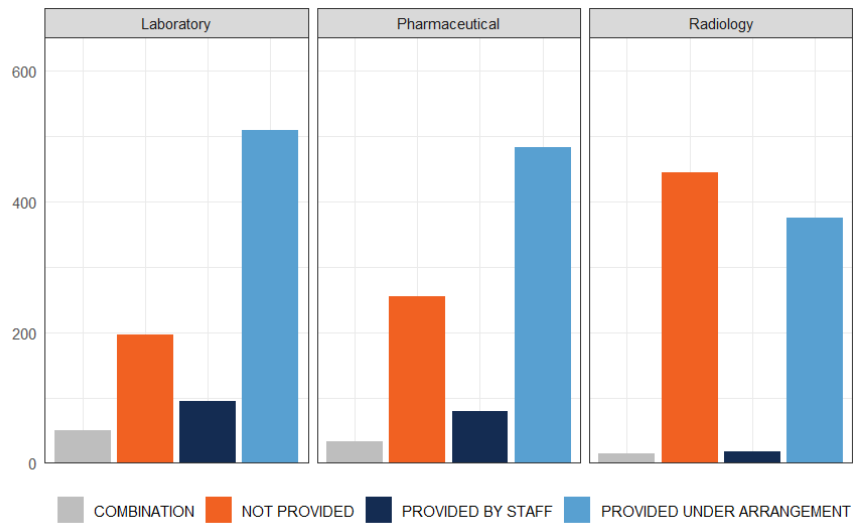

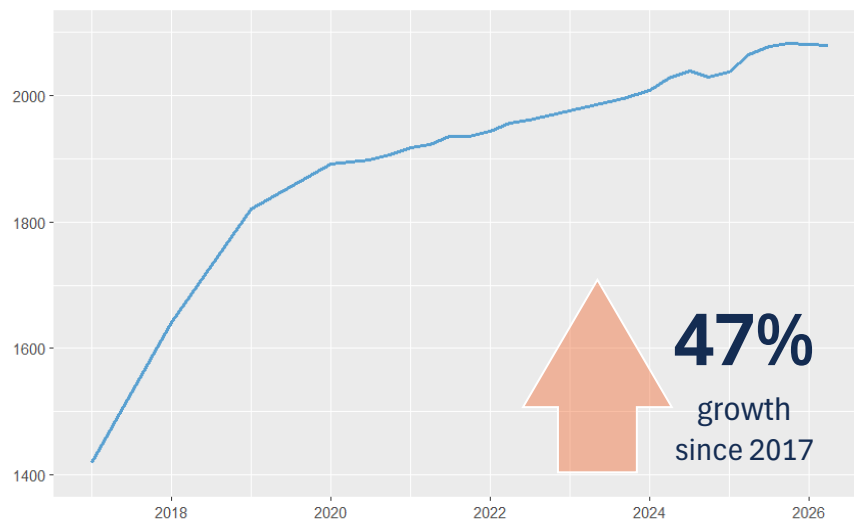

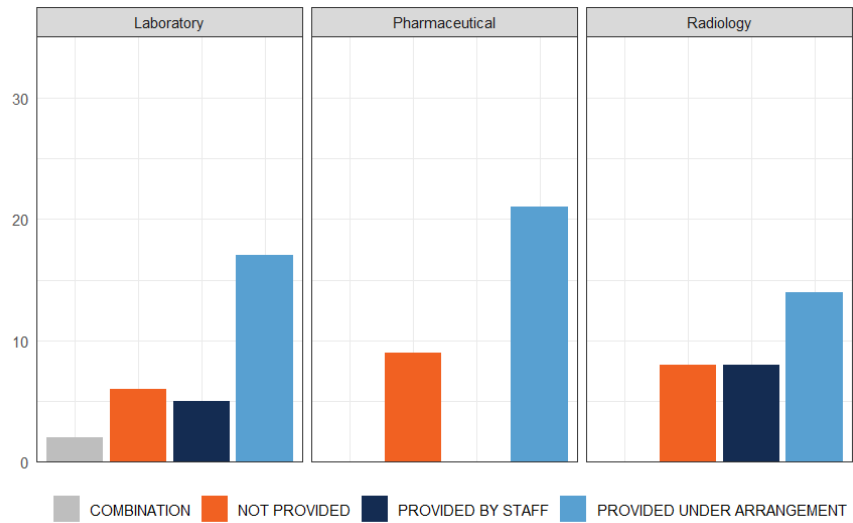

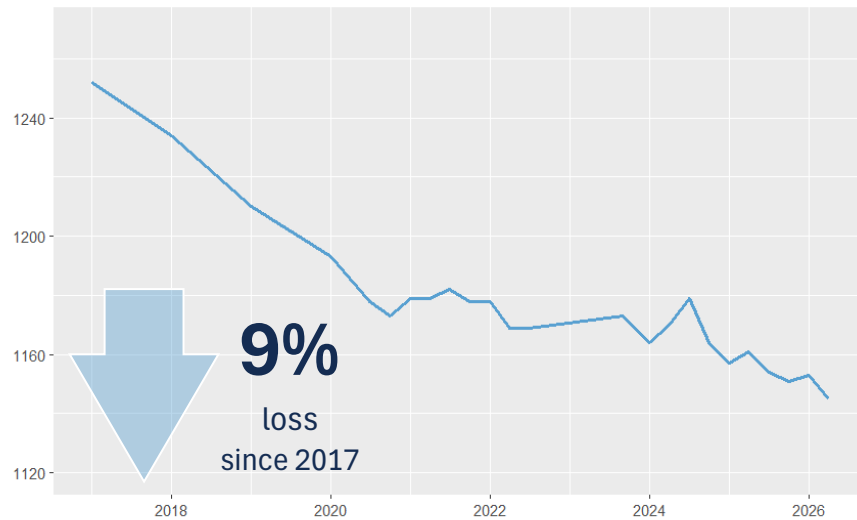

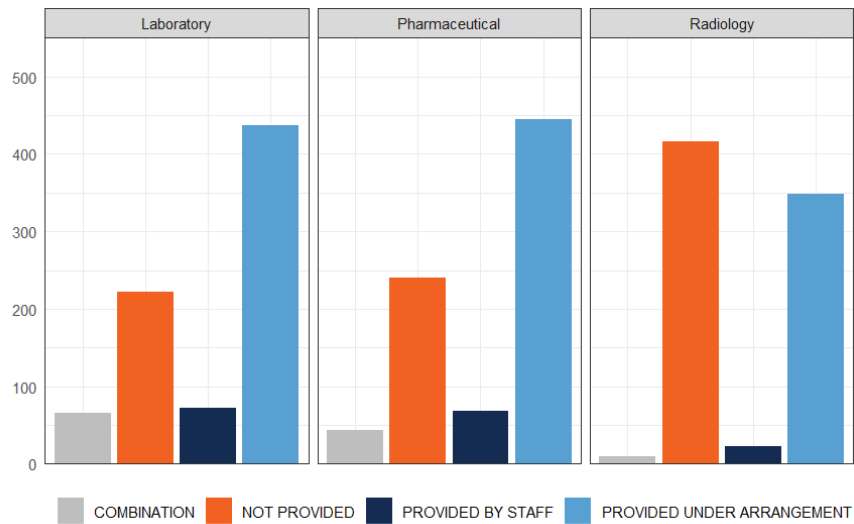

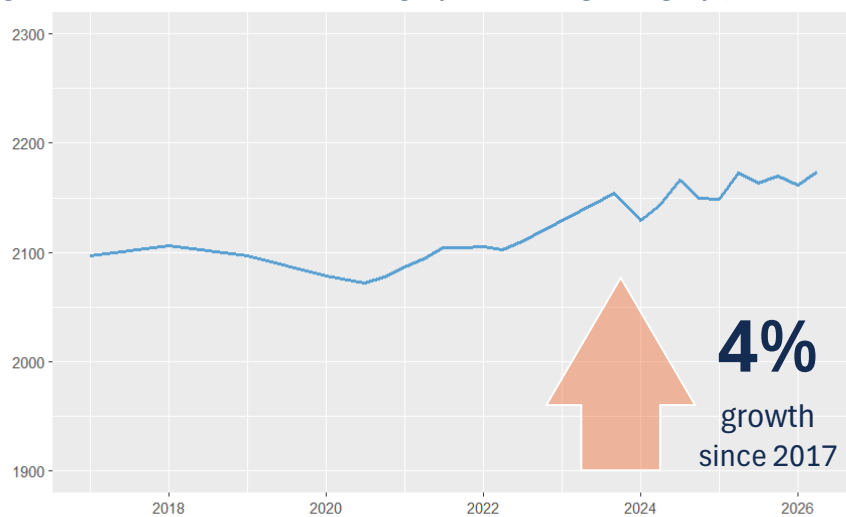

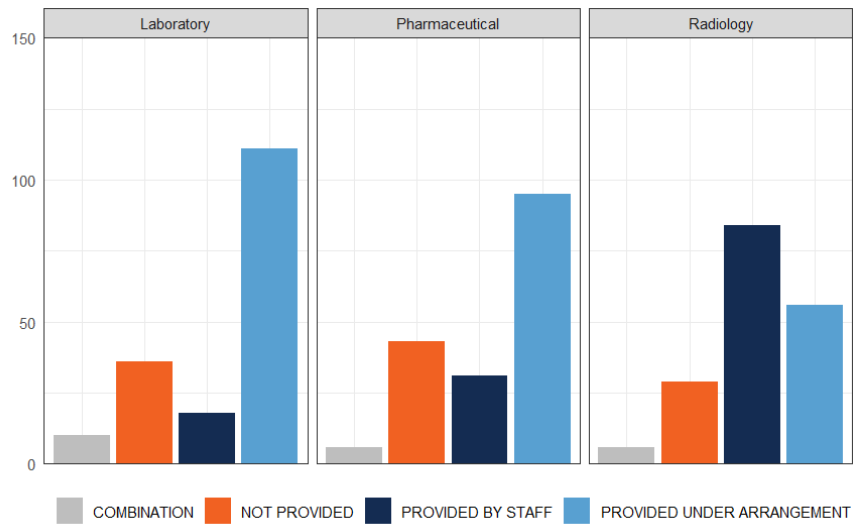

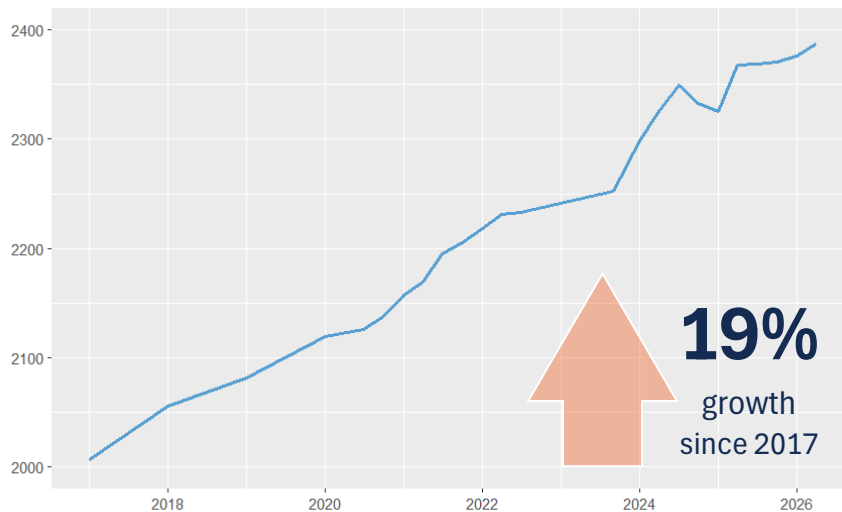

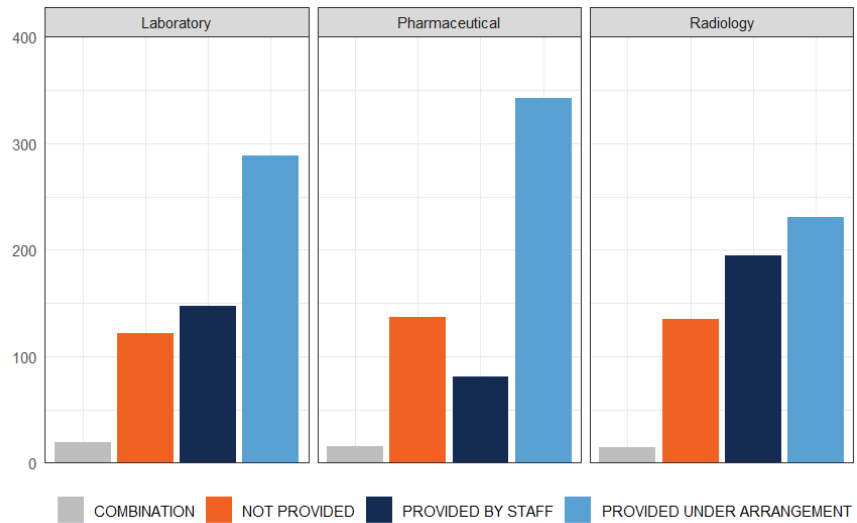

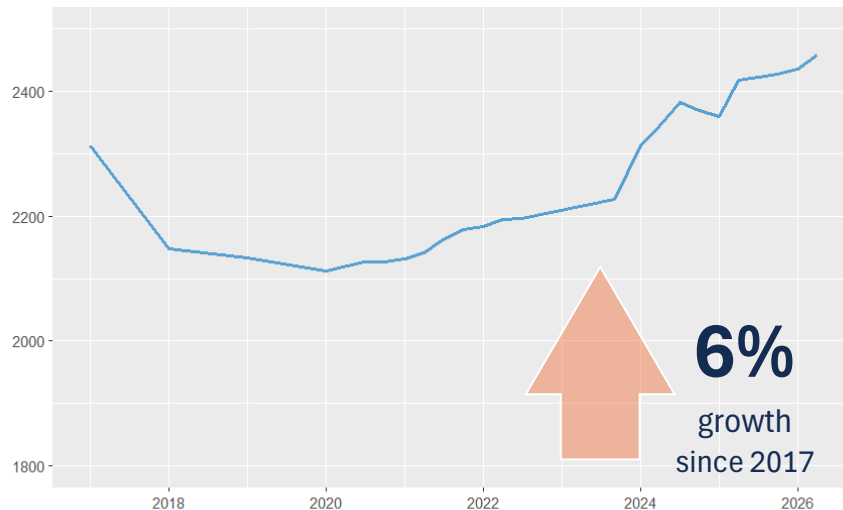

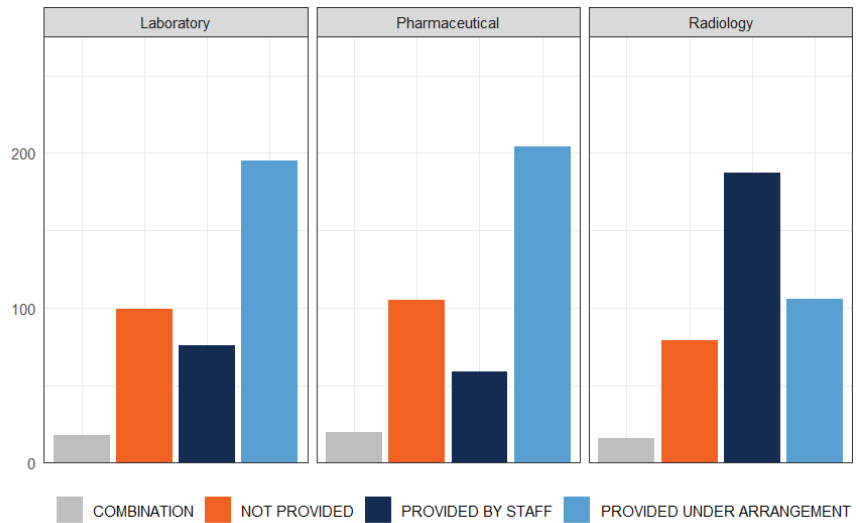

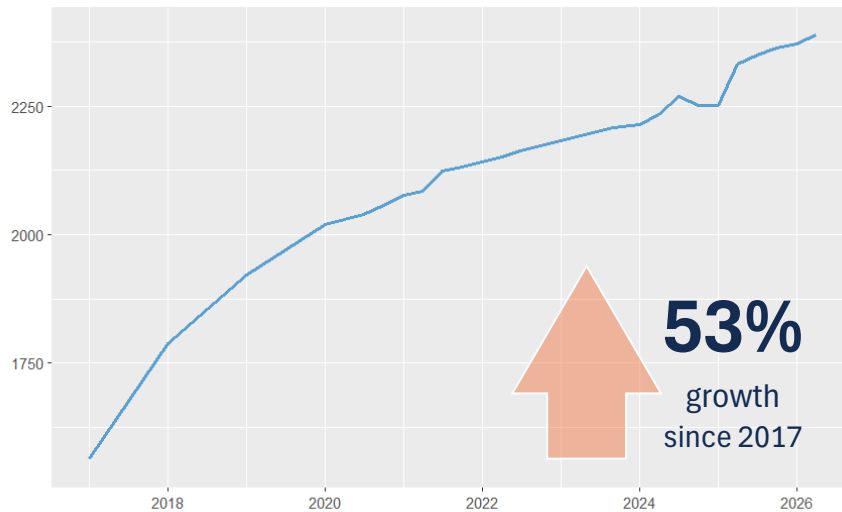

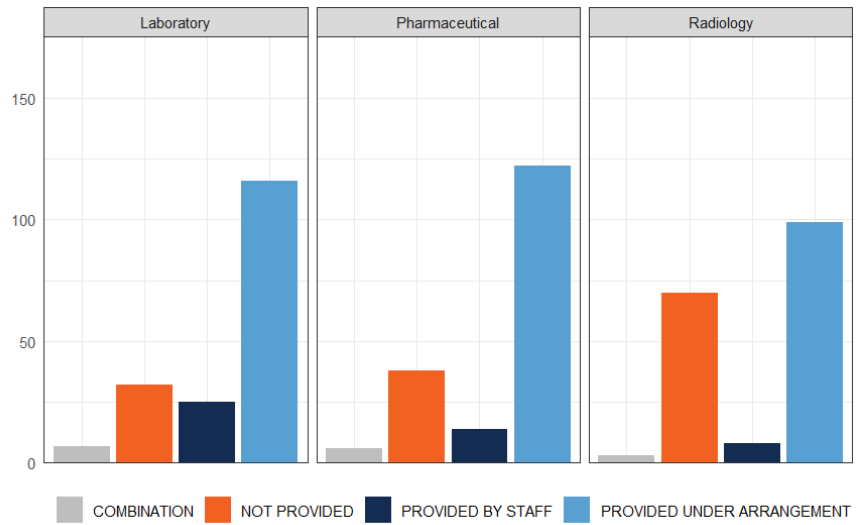

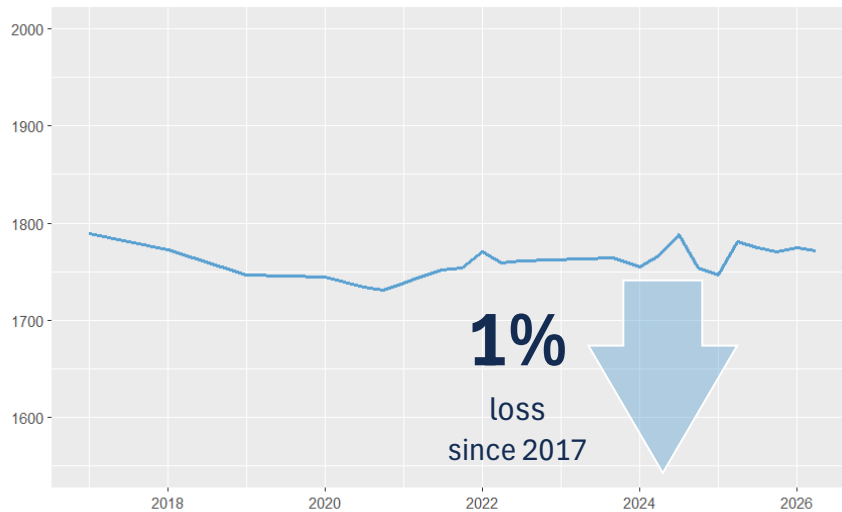

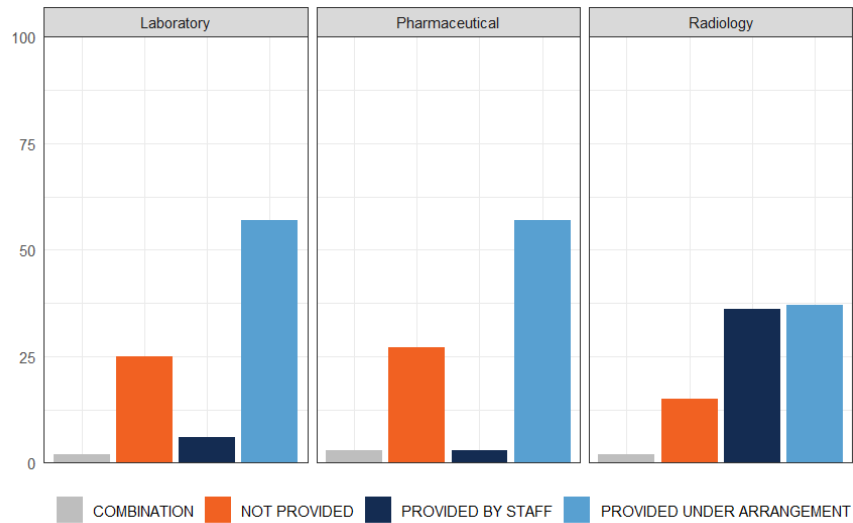

**There are currently 1,748 Medicare certified ASCs offering podiatric surgery, a 2.3% increase since 2017.**

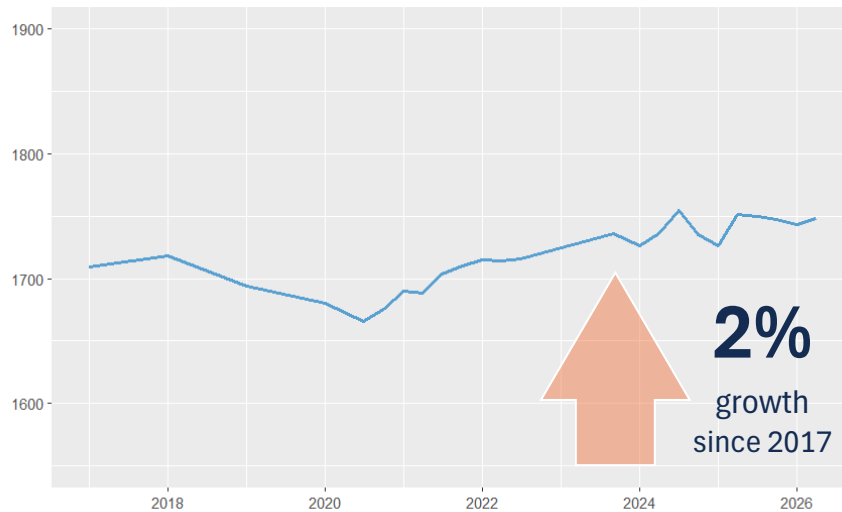

**Figure 31. Number of ASCs Offering Podiatric Surgery (2017-2026)**

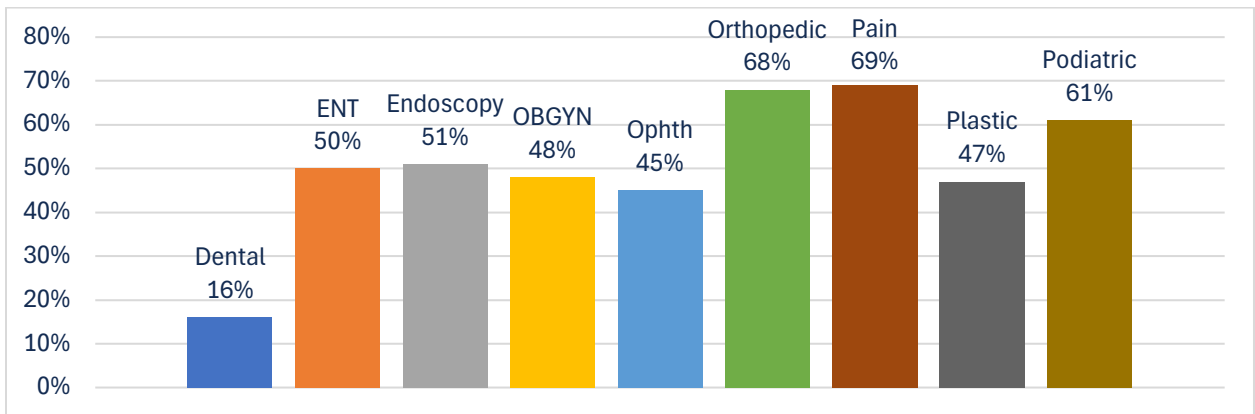


## Cardiovascular

At the end of Q1 2026, there were 265 Medicare-certified ASCs that were identified as offering cardiovascular surgery. 160 (60%) were single-specialty centers and 105 (40%) were multi-specialty centers.

The average number of specialties served at multi-specialty ASCs that offer cardiovascular surgery is 5.38, which is notably higher than multi-specialty ASCs that were not identified as offering cardiovascular surgery (average 4.57). The most common specialties offered in combination with cardiovascular are pain (69%), orthopedic (68%), and podiatric (61%).

**Figure 33. Count of cardiovascular ASCs by state**

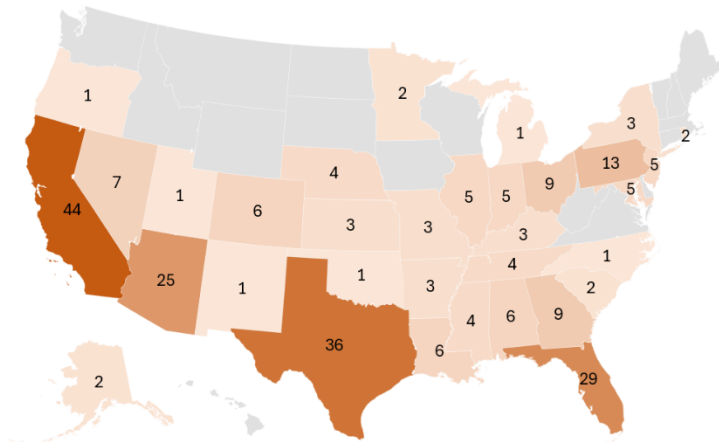
