Number of Medicare Certified ASCs

ASCs numbers across 50 states and D.C. territories represent 2,115 offices. Figures 1 and 2 show the number of ASCs by state. The top 10 states with the most ASCs are listed in Table 1 and the top 10 offices are in Table 2. 85% of all ASCs have an office in rural designation. Figure 3 displays the number of ASCs that were Medicare certified each year from 2000 to 2020.

Figure 2. ASCs by State per 100,000 People

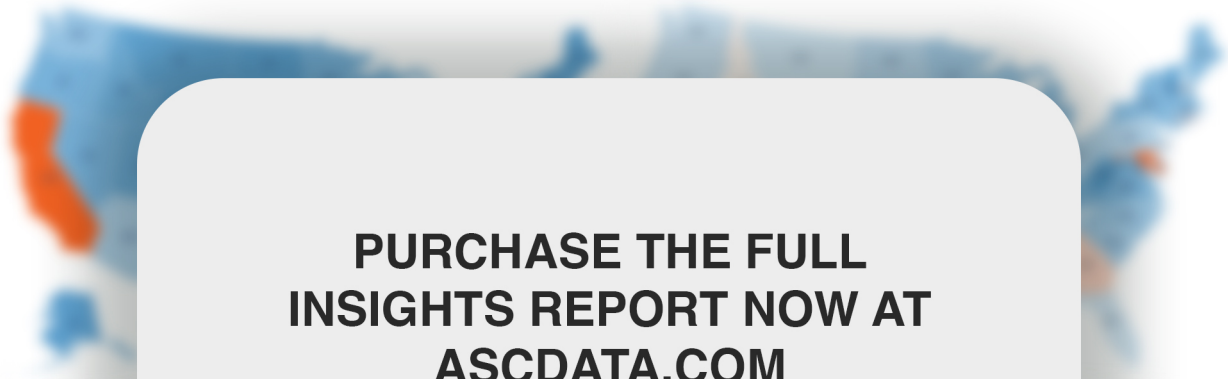
