Number of Medicare Certified ASCs.....3

Number of Medicare Certified ASCs

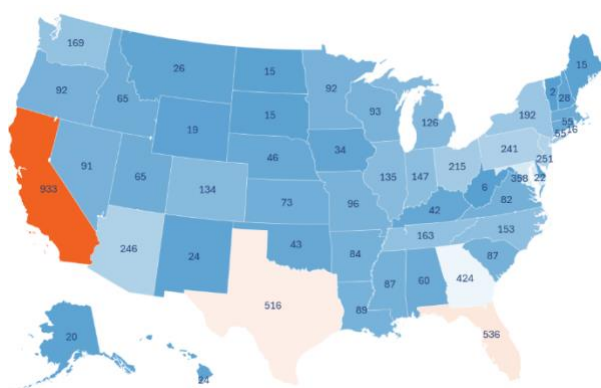


Figure 2. ASCs by State per 100,000 People

6,640 centers across 51 states and 3 US territories represent 2,114 cities. Figures 1 and 2 show the number of ASCs by state. The top 10 states with the most ASCs are listed in Table 1 and the top 10 cities are in Table 2. 91% of all ASCs have an urban (vs. rural) designation. Figure 3 displays the number of ASCs that were Medicare certified each year from 1980 to 2026.

Figure 1. ASCs by State

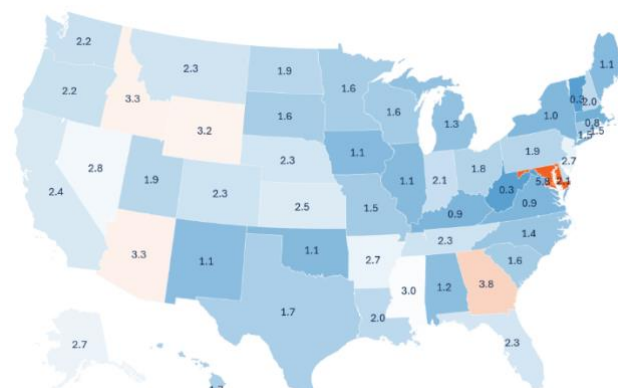


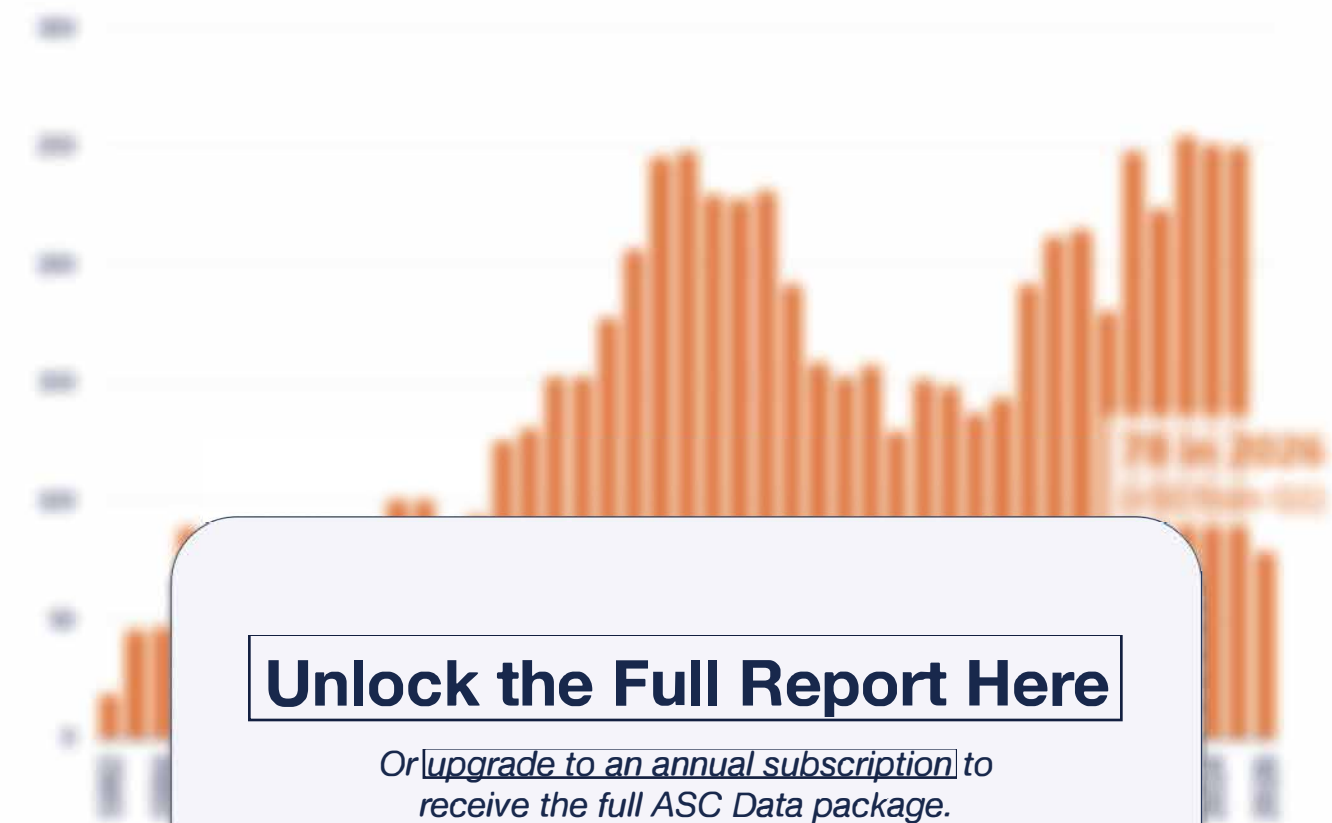
